IS ILLEGAL

Sexual harassment of the employees of this company will not be tolerated. We want all employees to know they can work in a safe workplace with security and dignity, and are not required to endure insulting, degrading or exploitative treatment.

Examples of Sexual Harassment include:

- Unwelcome sexual advances
- Requests for sexual favors
- Suggestive or lewd remarks
- Verbal/physical/visual conduct of a Sexual nature
- Pornographic posters, cartoons or Drawings
- Unwelcome sexual jokes or banter

Sexual Harassment is evidenced when:

- Submission to such conduct is made either explicitly or implicitly a term or condition of employment
- Submission to or rejection of the conduct is used as the basis for an employment decision; or
- The conduct has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with an individual's work performance or creating an intimidating or hostile work environment.
